A. DETAILS OF APPLICATION

This application is made under section 447A of the *Corporations Act 2001* (Cth) (**Act**) and section 90-15 of the Insolvency Practice Schedule (Corporations), being Schedule 2 to the Corporations Act (**IPSC**).

On the facts stated in the supporting affidavit of Sebastian David Hams sworn 26 February 2024, the First Plaintiffs seek the following orders:

1.
